In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Principal Commissioner or Commissioner of Customs under Handling of Cargo in Customs Areas Regulations, 2009, Section 8(b) and 45(1) of the Customs Act, 1962, I, Kajal Singh, Principal Commissioner of Customs, Bengaluru, hereby approve and appoint "M/S. **Bangalore International Airport Limited**" (a company registered under The Companies Act 2013) as Customs Cargo Service Provider and Custodian at Air Cargo Terminal at the Kempegowda International Airport, Devanahalli, Bengaluru under the said Handling of Cargo in Customs Areas Regulations, 2009, and Section 45(1) of the Customs Act, 1962 in the Customs Area, the limits of which are specified here below.

The Customs area for the above purposes shall be the area bound by boundaries and co-ordinates as under:

Boundaries:

North: Air side

East: Access road to Air Side

South: Road known as Cargo Road

West: Premises of Express cargo terminal

Coordinates (UTM):

Northwest: 792263.5614 Easting, 1460970.1892 Northing

North East: 792667.1263 Easting, 1460970.2722 Northing

South East: 792667.1263 Easting, 1460787.3735 Northing

South west: 7923828.9107 Easting, 1460787.4005 Northing

7923828.6036 Easting, 1460849.5801 Northing

792263.6665 Easting, 1460849.5121 Northing

2. This approval is subject to the applications and undertakings made by M/s BIAL and shall be effective from 24.05.2023 subject to the condition that M/s BIAL furnishes the Bonds, Bank Guarantees as required under regulation 5(3) and 5(4), undertaking as required under regulation 5(5), indemnity Bond as required under regulation 5(6) and provides insurance as required under regulation 5(1)(iii) of Handling of Cargo in Customs Areas Regulations, 2009 before the day of commencement of operations i.e. 24.05.2023. The approval, subject to the conditions specified herein shall be valid for a period of two years from 24.05.2023.

5. The approved Cargo Service Provider and Custodian shall:

- (i) comply with the provisions of Section 45(2) of the Customs Act 1962 and other provisions/Sections of the Customs Act, 1962 and Rules & regulations made thereunder as well as the instructions issued from time to time in this regard.
- (ii) be responsible for the proper receipt, handling, and storage of goods imported, meant for export or transshipment after their receipt and fulfil all conditions of Regulation 5(1) of Handling of Cargo in Customs Areas Regulations, 2009.
- (iii) be accountable for the loss of goods either imported or those meant for export or transshipment after their receipt and before their intended purpose.
- (iv) maintain proper record of all imported, exported or transhipped goods including those disposed of under Section 48 or otherwise.
- (v) be liable to pay duty on any imported/export/transshipment goods that are pilfered or lost after entry in customs area and in his custody.
- (vi) be responsible for any unauthorized removal of imported/export goods and shall be liable to pay appropriate duties, cess, etc on such removals.
- (vii) not sell or dispose imported/exported/transshipment goods without obtaining written permission from the proper officer of Customs under the Customs Act, 1962, which are not cleared for their intended purpose within 30 days or within the extended period as the proper officers may allow; or in case of goods in respect of which title has been relinquished by the importer in terms of Section 23(2) of the Customs Act, 1962.
- (viii) provide safe, secure and sufficient appropriate place for loading/unloading/storage of the cargo. The infrastructure for loading/unloading and storage operations should be designed to handle the projected traffic of the Air Cargo Complex and shall be suitably upgraded whenever necessary.
- (ix) provide sufficient modern handling equipment for handling the cargo, and shall upgrade the same periodically.
- (x) provide all modern infrastructure/Non Intrusive Inspection (NII) equipment including modern scanning machines, Karatmeter/ X-Ray fluorescence (XRF) spectrometer, Handheld narcotics Detectors/Kits etc. as are necessary for examination/inspection of the consignments/goods.
- (xi) provide sufficient and appropriately furnished office space for Customs officers and staff within the Air Cargo Terminal. Office space provided shall be conveniently located for efficient functioning of the Customs Staff. The custodian shall provide sufficient office space for customs in the Examination area which should be properly

demarcated. Office space provided shall be properly ventilated and maintained for Aesthetics, Hygiene and cleanliness by the Custodian. The furnishings shall be upgraded periodically and maintained regularly.

- (xii) not alter the plan in accommodation, boundary wall and building etc. without the concurrence and approval of the Principal Commissioner or Commissioner of Customs, Bengaluru.
- (xiii) provide all necessary IT infrastructure including network connectivity for functioning of the Customs staff, shall obtain an internet leased line, of sufficient bandwidth, to ensure that users do not face slowness or connectivity issues and shall also obtain a secondary internet leased line as backup, from any service provider other than the one from whom primary internet services have been obtained, to ensure that work is not affected if the service of one operator is not functional.
- (xiv) be responsible for complete security of the designated Customs area and the goods brought to/stored in the Area.
- (xv) undertake to bear the cost of the Customs officers posted, at such customs area, on cost recovery basis, by the Principal Commissioner or Commissioner and shall make payments at such rates and in the manner prescribed, unless specifically exempted by an order of the Government of India in the Ministry of Finance.
- (xvi) make adequate arrangements for sanitary facility, water supply and other facilities including canteen facility and shall provide appropriate amenities such as Rest rooms, Dining Areas, for both the Customs staff and Public.
- (xvii) not charge any rent/demurrage for the goods detained by the Customs Department under the Customs Act 1962 or any other law for the time being in force.
- (xviii) not lease, gift, sell or sublet or in any other manner transfer any of the premises in the specified customs area; or sub contract or outsource functions permitted or required to be carried out by him in terms of these regulations to any other person, without the prior written permission of The Principal Commissioner or Commissioner of Customs and the Custodian shall remain responsible for omissions and commissions of the said agency.
- (xix) provide unhindered thoroughfare to the Customs staff and such other authorised persons in the entire premises of the customs area.
- (xx) provide free suitable transport facility for the Customs staff posted for official work at the specified Customs Area.
- (xxi) if required and requisitioned by the Principal Commissioner or Commissioner of Customs, provide additional space and/or infrastructure.

4. The Principal Commissioner or Commissioner of Customs shall have the right to terminate the appointment at any time after assigning specific reasons for the same and providing opportunity to custodian to explain his case.

5. In the event of the Custodian found not being able to achieve and sustain expected service/delivery standards and is not able to improve even after being informed by the Principal Commissioner or Commissioner of Customs, Bengaluru the approving authority, the Principal Commissioner or Commissioner of Customs reserves the right to denotify, relocate the processing/handling activities to any other Custodian.

This may be brought to the notice of all concerned.
