Subject: Mandatory AWB Stickering and RFC compliance prior to Cargo tendering at Export Truck Dock – WFS and Menzies Cargo Terminal-Reg.

With reference to the above subject and earlier trade notices, and in view of sustained growth in export cargo volumes at Kempegowda International Airport Bengaluru, we remain committed to operational efficiency, service quality, and strict compliance with statutory and international air cargo standards.

Accordingly, we hereby inform you that, **with effect from 15th September 2026**, all export cargo tendered at the WFS and Menzies Cargo Terminals shall be accepted **only in Ready for Carriage (RFC) mode**.

In view of this, all shipments must have:

- A valid Air Waybill (AWB) sticker which needs to be securely affixed to each package of shipment.
- All applicable labels and shipment markings shall also be clearly displayed on every package.

These requirements are mandated to ensure compliance with statutory, regulatory, and international cargo handling standards and to improve the efficiency, accuracy, and traceability of export cargo acceptance.

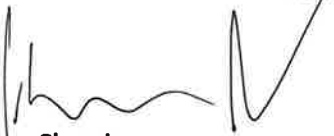
Accordingly, export cargo that does not meet the above requirements, including shipments with damaged, illegible, incorrect, or missing labels, shall not be accepted at the WFS and Menzies Cargo Terminals. Any discrepancies, delays, claims, regulatory observations, penalties, costs, or liabilities arising from such non-compliance shall be the sole responsibility of the respective CHA and/or Freight Forwarder.

All CHAs, Freight Forwarders, Exporters, and their operational teams are requested to ensure full compliance with these requirements before tendering export cargo at the terminals.
